Willowdale's races are run across two challenging courses set against natural rolling landscape. The hurdle races will run over natural hedges, while the timber course features solid post-and-rail timber fences, hedges, an open ditch, and water jumps.

The courses are set in a natural amphitheater enabling spectators to see most of the action from any location. General admission ticket holders can freely explore the property to view the races and mingle with friends.
